PRIMARY

Duration 2 Hours | Cost \$8

Additional \$5 per student for optional Arts Workshop (add 45 mins)

This package is suitable for all primary school students and features interactive intercultural games, group ice-breakers, cultural dress-ups, quizzes and more! It is relevant to a range of subject areas as well as Intercultural Capability/Understanding and Personal and Social Capability.



SECONDARY

Duration 2 Hours | Cost \$10

Additional \$5 per student for optional Arts Workshop (add 45 mins)

This package is perfect for secondary students (Years 7-12) seeking to explore our 5 permanent galleries including: Islamic Faith, Islamic Art, Islamic Architecture, Islamic Contributions to Civilisations, and Australian Muslim History. This package is relevant to a range of subject areas as well as Intercultural Capability/Understanding and Personal and Social Capability.



OTTOMANS

Discover the rich contributions of the Ottoman Empire to the world! Our guides will take you on a historical journey tracing Turkish influence on Smallpox inoculation, Ottoman coffee merchants in London and The Map of Piri Res. This package is relevant to studies of the Ottoman Empire in Year 8 History or VCE History.



MEDIAEAL EUROPE AND ISLAM

Duration 2 Hours | Cost \$10

Additional \$5 per student for optional Arts Workshop (add 45 mins)

This specialised tour will trace the significant contributions of Muslims to Medieval Europe, offering an alternate narrative of the 'Dark Ages'. This package is relevant to studies of Islam-West relations during the Medieval period, in Year 8 History or in the senior secondary years. It is intended to aid content learning as well as foster Intercultural Capability / Understanding.



BOUNDLESS PLAINS

Duration 2 Hours | Cost \$8 (Primary) \$10 (Secondary)

Additional \$5 per student for optional Arts Workshop (add 45 mins)

Emphasising the unique relationship between the first Muslims from Makassar, and Indigenous Australians – this tour unpacks the anthropological, social and cultural significance of this connection. This package is relevant to studies of Australian Muslim History in Years 4-6, Years 9-10, or VCE History. It is intended to aid content learning as well as foster Intercultural Capability / Understanding.
